

POSTAL BALLOT NOTICE

[Pursuant to Sections 108 and 110 of the Companies Act, 2013 read with Rule 20 and Rule 22 of the Companies (Management and Administration) Rules, 2014]

Dear Members,

Notice is hereby given that the resolution set out below is proposed to be passed by the Members of Ksolves India Limited ("the Company") by means of Postal Ballot through remote e-voting only, pursuant to the provisions of Sections 108 and 110 and all other applicable provisions of the Companies Act, 2013 ("the Act") read with Rules 20 and 22 of the Companies (Management and Administration) Rules, 2014 ("the Rules") (including any statutory modification(s) or re-enactment(s) thereof, for the time being in force) and in accordance with the guidelines prescribed by the Ministry of Corporate Affairs for inter-alia conducting postal ballot through e-voting vide General Circulars Nos. 14/2020, 17/2020, 22/2020, 33/2020 and 39/2020 dated April 8, 2020, April 13, 2020, June 15, 2020, September 28, 2020 and December 31, 2020 respectively ("MCA Circulars"), Regulation 44 of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015 ("SEBI LODR Regulations"), Secretarial Standard - 2 issued by the Institute of Company Secretaries of India and other applicable laws and regulations, if any. The explanatory statement pursuant to Section 102(1) of the Act setting out all material facts relating to the resolution mentioned in this Postal Ballot Notice is attached. In view of the current circumstances prevailing due to COVID-19 pandemic and in furtherance to the MCA Circulars, and pursuant to Section 110 of the Act and the Rules made thereunder, the Company will send Postal Ballot Notice only by email to all its shareholders who have registered their email addresses with the Company/ Registrar and Share Transfer Agent ("RTA") or Depository/ Depository Participants and the communication of assent/ dissent of the Members will only take place through the remote e-voting system. This Postal Ballot process is accordingly being initiated in compliance with the abovementioned MCA Circulars.

In compliance with the requirements of the MCA Circulars, physical copy of Postal Ballot Notice along with Postal Ballot Forms and pre-paid business envelope will not be sent to the shareholders for this Postal Ballot and shareholders are required to communicate their assent or dissent through the remote e-voting system only.

The Board of Directors of the Company has appointed Mr. Arpit Gupta (Membership No. - 421544), Partner of M/s A Y & Company (Formerly Known as M/s Arpit R Gupta & Company) Practicing Chartered Accountants, as the Scrutinizer for conducting the Postal Ballot through remote e-voting process in a fair and transparent manner and he has communicated his willingness to be appointed and will be available for the said purpose. In compliance with the provisions of Sections 108 and 110 of the Act read with Rule 20 and Rule 22 of the Companies (Management and Administration) Rules, 2014 and Regulation 44 of SEBI LODR Regulations and the MCA Circulars, the Company has provided remote electronic voting ("remote e-voting") facility only for this postal ballot process. The Company has engaged the services of Central Depository Services (India) Limited ("CDSL") to provide a remote e-voting facility to the Members of the Company. Please refer to the instructions for remote e-voting given after the proposed resolution for the process and manner in which remote e-voting is to be carried out. The remote e-voting period shall commence on **Saturday, July 16, 2022 (9:00 A.M. IST) and end on Sunday, August 14, 2022 (5.00 P.M. IST) (both days inclusive)**. Members are requested to carefully read the instructions while expressing their assent or dissent and cast a vote via remote e-voting by not later than the close of working hours at 5.00 P.M. (IST) on Sunday, August 14, 2022. Upon completion of remote e-voting, the Scrutinizer will submit his report to the Chairman of the Company or any other person authorized by him in writing, who shall countersign the same. The Results of the postal ballot will be announced no later than 5.00 P.M. (IST) on Tuesday, August 16, 2022. The said result along with the Scrutinizer's report would be communicated to National Stock Exchange of India Limited where the shares of the Company are presently listed. Additionally, the Results will also be uploaded on the Company's website viz. www.ksolves.com, the website of National Stock Exchange of India Limited viz www.nseindia.com, where the shares of the company are listed and on the website of CDSL viz. www.evotingindia.com.

THE INTRUCTIONS OF SHAREHOLDERS FOR REMOTE E-VOTING ARE AS UNDER:

- (i) The voting period begins on **Saturday, July 16, 2022 at 9:00 a.m** and ends on **Sunday, August 14, 2022 at 5:00 p.m.** During this period shareholders of the Company, holding shares as of **Wednesday, July 13, 2022** (the cut-off date) may cast their vote electronically. The e-voting module shall be disabled by CDSL for voting thereafter.
- (ii) Pursuant to SEBI Circular No. **SEBI/HO/CFD/CMD/CIR/P/2020/242 dated 09.12.2020**, under Regulation 44 of Securities and Exchange Board of India (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015, listed entities are required to provide remote e-voting facility to its shareholders, in respect of all shareholders' resolutions. However, it has been observed that the participation by the public non-institutional shareholders/retail shareholders is at a negligible level.

Currently, there are multiple e-voting service providers (ESPs) providing e-voting facility to listed entities in India. This necessitates registration on various ESPs and maintenance of multiple user IDs and passwords by the shareholders.

In order to increase the efficiency of the voting process, pursuant to a public consultation, it has been decided to enable e-voting to **all the demat account holders, by way of a single login credential, through their demat accounts/ websites of Depositories/ Depository Participants.** Demat account holders would be able to cast their vote without having to register again with the ESPs, thereby, not only facilitating seamless authentication but also enhancing ease and convenience of participating in e-voting process.

- (iii) In terms of SEBI circular no. SEBI/HO/CFD/CMD/CIR/P/2020/242 dated December 9, 2020 on e-Voting facility provided by Listed Companies, Individual shareholders holding securities in demat mode are allowed to vote through their demat account maintained with Depositories and Depository Participants. Shareholders are advised to update their mobile number and email Id in their demat accounts in order to access e-Voting facility.

 - c. Shareholders holding shares in Physical Form should enter Folio Number registered with the Company.
- 4) Next enter the Image Verification as displayed and Click on Login.

- (v) After entering these details appropriately, click on “SUBMIT” tab.
- (vi) Shareholders holding shares in physical form will then directly reach the Company selection screen. However, shareholders holding shares in demat form will now reach ‘Password Creation’ menu wherein

they are required to mandatorily enter their login password in the new password field. Kindly note that this password is to be also used by the demat holders for voting for resolutions of any other company on which they are eligible to vote, provided that company opts for e-voting through CDSL platform. It is strongly recommended not to share your password with any other person and take utmost care to keep your password confidential.

(vii) For shareholders holding shares in physical form, the details can be used only for e-voting on the resolutions contained in this Notice.

(viii) Click on the **EVSN- 220712012** for the relevant <**KSOLVES INDIA LIMITED**> on which you choose to vote.

(ix) On the voting page, you will see “RESOLUTION DESCRIPTION” and against the same the option “YES/NO” for voting. Select the option YES or NO as desired. The option YES implies that you assent to the Resolution and option NO implies that you dissent to the Resolution.

(x) Click on the “RESOLUTIONS FILE LINK” if you wish to view the entire Resolution details.

(xi) After selecting the resolution, you have decided to vote on, click on “SUBMIT”. A confirmation box will be displayed. If you wish to confirm your vote, click on “OK”, else to change your vote, click on “CANCEL” and accordingly modify your vote.

(xii) Once you “CONFIRM” your vote on the resolution, you will not be allowed to modify your vote.

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT PURSUANT TO SECTION 102(1) OF THE COMPANIES ACT, 2013 ('the Act')

RESOLUTION 1: MIGRATION OF EQUITY SHARES OF THE COMPANY FROM EMERGE PLATFORM OF THE NATIONAL STOCK EXCHANGE OF INDIA LIMITED (NSE) TO THE MAIN BOARD OF THE NATIONAL STOCK EXCHANGE OF INDIA LIMITED (NSE) AND BSE LIMITED (BSE).

The Company was listed on Emerge Platform of The National Stock Exchange of India Limited (NSE) on July 06, 2020. As per SEBI (Issue of Capital and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2018 ("**ICDR Regulations**"), equity shares listed on Emerge Platform can be migrated to the Main Board of Stock Exchange after an initial period of 2 years from the date of listing satisfying the other requisite criteria. Fulfilling all the applicable criteria, the Company intends to migrate to the Main Board of The National Stock Exchange of India Limited (NSE) and Main Board of BSE Limited (BSE) as per the guidelines specified by the procedures laid down under Chapter IX of SEBI (ICDR) Regulations, 2018.

The Migration of the Company from Emerge Platform of The National Stock Exchange of India Limited to the Main Board of The National Stock Exchange of India Limited and BSE Limited is also subject to the approval of Members by way of passing Special Resolution in terms of Chapter IX of ICDR Regulations. Provided Special Resolution shall be acted upon if and only if the votes cast by shareholders other than the promoters in favor of the proposal amount to at least two times the number of votes cast by shareholders other than the promoter's shareholding against the proposal.

Accordingly, the Board recommends the resolution set forth in Item No. 1 to be passed as a Special Resolution by the Members of the Company through Postal Ballot.

None of the Directors, Key Managerial Personnel of the Company, and their respective relatives are, concerned or interested except in the Resolution set out in Item No. 1 of this Notice except to the extent of their shareholding held by them in the Company.
